**JOURNEYS FROM THE CENTRE OF THE EARTH (PACIFIC RIM) PERU: BBC2** Series looking at Geology explaining how the world around is formed. Presented by Iain Stewart.

**TIME TEAM: Channel 4** Three series of the long running archeological series.

**OUTBREAK: (MACHUPO/ E COLI 157)** Two films in a drama documentary series for National Geographic, looking at major outbreaks of disease and how they were combated. I also took the stills.

**THE HARD SELL:** BBC 6 X 30 mins documentary series looking at the history of TV advertising.

**DISPATCHES: “My Family and Alzheimer’s”** C4 TV presenter Fiona Phillips, who’s father suffers from the disease, investigates the struggle faced by Alzheimer’s sufferers.

**VIRTUAL REVOLUTION: BBC** Series looking at the worldwide web, its history and how it has changed our lives.

**DAYS THAT SHOOK THE WORLD: JFK/PRESIDENT NIXON/THE GREAT TRAIN ROBBERY/ GARY POWERS/ADOLF HITLER DIARIES/WAR OF THE WORLDS/REVOLUTION/ CAMBRIDGE SPIES.** Series for Lion Television Scotland for BBC. Drama reconstruction series showing the events that led up to an historic moment in our time through the eyes of those involved.

**LIGHT FANTASTIC:** BBC. Documentary series looking at the science and history of light, presented by Simon Schaffer.

**DISPATCHES: “UNDERCOVER MOSQUE”:** C4 An undercover investigation.**SCIENCE AND ISLAM: BBC** 3 x 1 hour documentary series in the Middle East, Arabia, Africa and Europe about early groundbreaking scientific discoveries in the Islamic world.

**THE EMPIRE:** Wark Clements/BBC. Second of a 6 part series about the expansion of the Empire. My films were about Australasia and the Far East

**ATOM: BBC.** 3 x 1 hour documentary series on the atom. The films look into the history of atomic science, the work of scientists such as Einstein and Bohr, as well as what the future may bring. **Commendation at the Grierson Documentary Awards**

**THE SEVEN AGES OF BRITAIN:** Wildfire for Channel 4. A major History series, looking at Britain from the Ice Age to the Industrial Revolution.

**TALES FROM EUROPE:** IWC/BBC. 8 x 30 mins. A series of travelogues with Kirsty Wark. The series looked at how the former communist countries would change when they joined the EU in 2004. ( I shot 6 progs. Slovenia, Hungary, Czech Republic, Poland, Lithuania and Latvia.)

**GRAND DESIGNS:** Talkback. Channel 4. Documentary series of 1 hour programs, each one featuring someone building their dream home.

**SATURDAY/SUNDAY:** C4. (Oxford Films) Observational documentary about how people spend the weekend.

**DEATH BY EXCESS:** Oxford Scientific Films for Sky One. A series looking at celebrities who have died through drug abuse. I shot the film about Mama Cass, Billie Holliday and Janis Joplin.
